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New WorkForce West Virginia Office to open in Fairmont July 27

FAIRMONT, W.Va. – WorkForce West Virginia will open its new Fairmont office at 320 Adams Street, Suite 107, on July 27, following the closure of its previous location earlier this year. Onsite assistance and services will resume in the Fairmont location effective 8:30 a.m. Monday.

Clients can visit the new Fairmont office five days a week beginning July 27, or call 1-800-252-5627 for assistance and additional information. Office hours are Monday through Thursday 8:30 a.m. - 5 p.m. and Friday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

The former WorkForce West Virginia location at 109 Adams Street was closed February 20, 2009, due to structural problems with the building. The agency's 10-person staff had to be temporarily relocated to the Clarksburg and Morgantown offices while a new facility was prepared.
